GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

- 1. The facility of online filing of examination application form is provided to the students. The students can file the application from their own place.
- 2. In case of difficulties, students can request the college to file his/her application form from the college.
 - "In both the above cases, it is the responsibility of the college to ensure that, the correct data is entered".
- 3. Application filing by the students is made available at URL: https://prexam.vtu.ac.in
- 4. USER id and password are already given to the students during August/September 2020 Examinations and the same can be used.
 - In case, you have forgotten the USER id and Password USER id will be your USN and you must obtain your password from the college.
- 5. File your application carefully and take a printout and verify.
- 6. Uploading your recent passport size (Max 40 Kb) Photo is mandatory
- 7. After complete verification, requisite fee is to be paid as per the mode of payment of fee decided by the college.
- 8. No corrections in the approved application is permitted, once it is approved by the college.
- 9. Be Present at the College Campus at least 1 hours 30 minutes before the starting examinations.
- 10. Wearing of Mask and Hand Gloves at all times and location is compulsory.
- 11. Students are permitted to use their own hand sanitizer.
- 12. If you have any symptoms such as fever, cough, cold etc., request the college authorities for separate seating arrangements at least one day before your exams.
- 13. Carry your own water bottle, pen, pencil, calculator, data handbook etc.,
- 14. Do not share your belongings with anybody.
- 15. Check your belongings and pockets for any written material and electronics devises other than calculator which should not result into Malpractice.
- 16. Strictly adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures issued by UGC, State Government and the University in the conduct of examinations

17. NOTE:

- a. The students with any number of backlog subjects can take admission to odd semester 2020-2021
- b. 2017 batch students who have not gained eligibility to 3rd semester are required to take readmission to the course from 1st semester.
- c. Students of 2017 batch are not permitted to continue in 2nd year without eligibility as per norms.
- d. Candidates appeared for Terminal Semester November 2020 Special Exams will not be permitted to appear for terminal semester subjects.
- e. Candidates eligible to appear for Terminal Semester November 2020 Special exams and not appeared for Special Exams will not be permitted to appear for Feb/March 2021 exams for Terminal semester subjects.
- f. Such Students (as shown in 17d and 17e above) may appear for terminal semester subjects during June/July 2021 exams.
- g. Such students are permitted to appear for backlog subjects of lower semesters, if any.
