

The approval accorded to your institution shall be subject to appointment of adequate Faculty of Architecture and maintenance of physical infrastructure & facilities at your institution in terms of Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020, prior to commencement of academic session 2024-2025. The institution shall be required to appoint faculty to fill up any vacancy, as may be required, within 15 days in case of any faculty leaving the institution.

The final observations of the Executive Committee are mentioned below for your information and compliance:

- Adequate Infrastructure and cadre-wise qualified faculty as per COA Norms should be appointed/ maintained by the institution at all times.

The institution shall initiate necessary remedial actions, if any, based on the observations of the Executive Committee and send its compliance/observations on the same for further consideration. The Council shall be at liberty to inspect the Institution at any point of time to verify the compliance made by the institution and to ascertain that the institution is imparting architectural course as per the Norms prescribed by the Council, from time to time. In case any discrepancy in regard to the information supplied by the institution is found at any stage, appropriate action shall be initiated against the institution.

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NORMS OF COUNCIL OF ARCHITECTURE FOR IMPARTING B.ARCH.COURSE

1. **5-year full-time Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch.)** degree course is to be imparted by an architectural institution in an independent building and land having its own infrastructure and budgetary provisions, as provided under Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020, prescribed by the Council.

Institution must own a minimum 8000 Sq. M. or Independent or undivided and contiguous share of land adequate enough to provide for built floor space of 2,000 Sq.M. for Intake of 40; 3,000 Sq.M. for intake of 80; and 4,000 Sq.M. for intake of 120 in B.Arch. course; provided further that the built space should be contiguous. An institution applying for additional intake shall be required to create adequate infrastructural facilities in proportion to the additional intake sought, as and when sanctioned by the Council (as per the Minimum Standards). The Institution shall ensure that its building and premises and other spaces must be barrier free (i.e. disabled friendly).


2. The Institution must have valid affiliation with a University established by an Act of the Central or State Legislature or conferred authority by Law to award Degree Course in Architecture. **No admission shall be made by the Institution without valid affiliation with a University.** NOC/affiliation letter from the university must be obtained and submitted to the Council at the earliest.
3. The Institution having intake of more than 40 students shall be required to conduct separate classes for each batch of 40 candidates or part thereof.
4. The Institution shall be required to appoint/maintain the Faculty of Architecture and Physical Infrastructure & Facilities as per the under Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020.
5. The eligibility criteria for admission to 1st of 5-year B.Arch. degree course for 2024-2025 is as under:

“No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50 per cent. Aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also at least 50 per cent. marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50 per cent. marks in aggregate.”

The candidates must have passed the mandatory subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at 10+2 level or compulsory subject of Mathematics at 10+3 Diploma level.

6. No direct lateral admission of any student into any year/stage of the B.Arch. course is allowed as per Council Norms.
7. All admissions made by the institution under various quotas/categories must be strictly within the intake sanctioned by the Council for an academic session. The students belonging to NRI, Foreign National, PIO etc. are also required to be admitted within the sanctioned intake, subject to passing an aptitude test. Further, reservation of students/relaxation of marks in qualifying examination for admission to the B.Arch. course for reserved categories shall be as per the policy of the Central/ respective State Government.
8. All admissions must be completed by the institution before **1st September** i.e. the date of commencement of B.Arch. classes (or as amended by the Council) prescribed by the Council. The institution should apply for enrolment of students admitted for the academic session 2024-2025 at the portal of the Council latest by September 30, 2024.
9. The Institution shall follow the Duration and Stages of the Course, Admission to the Architecture Course, Courses and periods of Studies, Standards of staff, equipment, accommodation, training and other facilities for architectural education as per the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education prescribed by the Council from time to time,

10. The institution must acquire minimum 300 books on subjects of Architecture in its library for an intake of 40 (including minimum 100 titles) before the commencement of the course. Please add 150 books (including minimum 50 titles) for every additional intake of 40. From 2nd year onwards, minimum 120 books (including minimum 40 titles) for every year per intake of 40. Library of old schools, having more than 5000 books, should acquire minimum 10 titles on subjects of Architecture per intake of 40 every year.
11. As per Regulations, 2020, in a selection Committee as prescribed by any Institution or University for Selection Process of faculty, there shall be one Nominee of the Council, who shall act as full-fledged member of such Selection Committee constituted for the purpose of recruitment and /or promotion of faculty, except for Centrally Funded Technical institutions (CFTIs). Therefore, recruitments or promotions made to architecture faculty positions in the Institution without COA nominee shall not be deemed valid by the Council.
12. The Head as well as other core Architecture teaching faculty of the institution must have valid registration as an Architect from the Council of Architecture under the Architects Act, 1972. The Experience shall mean professional experience and/or Teaching and/or Research in the field of Architecture, counted from the date of registration with Council for core faculty.
13. The Institution shall initiate necessary steps to curb ragging in its premises and take appropriate action as prescribed by competent authority in case of any such incident.
14. The Institution shall ensure that women (staff, faculty or student) are protected against sexual harassment at the institution and initiate necessary steps as prescribed by competent authority.
15. All the circulars/ notices including the intake sanctioned by the Council to Institution(s) shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the Institution for information of the students and faculty members. The same shall be available on the website of the institution along with details regarding physical & academic infrastructure and faculty.
16. Any Institution which fails to maintain the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education shall be liable to attract sanctions which may include recommendation for withdrawal of recognition the qualification imparted at the Institution.
17. The affiliating University of the institution should preferably create an independent Faculty of Architecture and independent Board of Studies in Architecture for proper growth and development of course in Architecture and prepare Syllabus, Course Curriculum, Scheme of Examination in accordance with the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education as prescribed by Council. At least 1/3 of its members should be from the field of practice in Architecture.
18. In due course, the affiliating University is advised to create a Board of Studies in Architecture, Interior Design, Building Construction Technology etc. under the Faculty of Architecture to deal with issues connected with these disciplines at UG and PG level, having at least 1/3 of its members from practice.
19. The institution is advised to constitute an independent Governing Council for a School of Architecture, having Architect members in majority. The institution may also create Course Committees for continuous development of educational programme in Architecture. At least 1/3 of its member may be from practice.



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NORMS OF COUNCIL OF ARCHITECTURE FOR IMPARTING M.ARCH. COURSE

1. **Space & Building:**
The University or Institution shall possess a minimum 8000.00 Square meters or Independent or undivided and contiguous share of land adequate enough to provide for built floor space sufficient for the existing intake of UG course and minimum additional built-up area of 250.00 Sq. Meters per intake of 20 for each Post-Graduate degree programme(s). The built space should be contiguous with, and may have some shared facilities with the under-graduate programme as given in the above Table No. – 5.0 of Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education for Post – Graduate Degree Programme) Guidelines, 2022. The Institution shall ensure that its building and premises and other spaces must be barrier free (i.e. disabled friendly).
2. **Eligibility for Admission:**
No candidate shall be admitted to Post Graduate full time degree or Certificate programme unless the candidate has passed an examination in B. Arch. Degree or equivalent with at least 50 percent aggregate marks or equivalent CGPI.
3. **Teaching Faculty:** For an annual intake of 20 students, the institution offering post-graduate programmes shall have a minimum core faculty consisting of 1 Professor, 1 Associate Professor and 1 Assistant Professor for each post-graduate course along with visiting faculty as per COA Norms. Teacher - Student ratio for studio subject shall be 1:5 and for theory subjects shall be 1:20. The load allotted to each visiting faculty as well as experts from the profession / industry shall be clearly indicated by the University/ Institution in addition to the core faculty so as to achieve and maintain the stipulated ratios.
4. **Facilities & Staff:** The institute shall have Activity Spaces for each Post-Graduate programme of 2 year duration as detailed out in Appendix-C of the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education for Post – Graduate Degree Programme) Guidelines, 2022, prescribed by the Council.
5. **Library:** The Library area to be provided with facility for e-library. Minimum 75 books (including minimum 50 Titles) on subjects exclusive to specialization of Post-Graduate degree programme shall be available in library for intake of 20 at the time of first inspection and first year of commencement of the PG degree programme. 50 books (including minimum 20 Titles) on subjects of Post-Graduate degree programme to be added for additional intake of 20 at the time of inception. For every subsequent year a minimum of 20 books on subjects of Post-Graduate programme (including minimum 10 titles) per batch of 20 intake to be added. Journals and Periodicals relevant to PG degree programmes shall be subscribed.
6. **Computer Facility:** Separate dedicated Computers shall be provided for every PG degree programme. A minimum of 5 desktops per PG Programme per batch of 20 having relevant and contextual licensed software shall be provided.
7. **Labs & Workshop:** As per the requirement of the course structure of the post graduate programme necessary laboratories and workshops should be established ensuring necessary equipment in order to provide quality education in the specialization.
8. **Reservation of Candidates:** Reservation of seats and relaxation in percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination for admission shall be as per the reservation policy of Central Government or the respective State Governments.
9. The institution shall adhere to the Norms and Guidelines as prescribed by the Council in the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education for Post – Graduate Degree Programme) Guidelines, 2022 and as prescribed from time to time. The institution shall also follow the instructions given by the Council of Architecture for improvement / up-gradation and proper maintenance and submit periodic reports of action taken by the institution to the Council.
10. The Institution shall initiate necessary steps to curb ragging in its premises and take appropriate action as prescribed by competent authority in case of any such incident.
11. The Institution shall ensure that women (staff, faculty or student) are protected against sexual harassment at the institution and initiate necessary steps as prescribed by competent authority.
12. All the circulars/ notices including the intake sanctioned by the Council to Institution(s) shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the Institution for information of the students and faculty members.



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
