- 13. In case any incident occurs proper documentation of the same is important. Consent of the complainant is very important in the case. The complainant either gives a written complaint and in case refuses to give in writing, then the Committee shall record and then the complainant has to sign the same.
- 14. "Tell me" box to be set up for recording any complaints anonymously.
- 15. Reports to be sent to VTU / COA/ UGC every year.
- 16. The Vishaka commission should be known to all the members (All faculty members).
- 17. Review of the understanding of members after meeting has to be recorded in the best interest of the institution.
- 18. Have a mentor (counsellor) on board.
- 19. Safety of every kind has be ensured at work place.
- 20. Any kind of harassment that hinders personal/professional growth of a person should not happen at work place.
- 21. Life skills by WHO should be emphasized to all faculty and students.


